Call to Order.

On Monday, December 5, 1983, at 9:30 A.M. (the day and hour appointed for the meeting), Honorable Harold Washington, Mayor, called the meeting to order. Daniel J. Burke, Deputy City Clerk, called the roll of members and it was found that there were present at that time:

Invocation.

Alderman George J. Hagopian, 30th Ward, opened the meeting with prayer.

At this point in the proceedings, Mayor Washington addressed the Council, noting that in response to the problem of street light outages, the Department of Streets and Sanitation had assigned additional repair crews and expected the problem to be alleviated no later than January 1. The Mayor also explained that the problem had been caused by faulty bulbs which would be replaced by the manufacturer on a two for one basis.

Mayor Washington then recognized Alderman Pucinski who expressed appreciation for the Department of Streets and Sanitation's prompt response to the situation.

After comment by Aldermen Mell and Damato, Alderman Oberman moved to *Adjourn*. The motion *Prevailed* and the City Council *Stood Adjourned*.
