Referred -- LEVY OF TAXES SUFFICIENT TO PAY PRINCIPAL
OF AND INTEREST ON ISSUANCE OF GENERAL
OBLIGATION SCHOOL ASSISTANCE BONDS.

Aldermen Orr and Volini presented a proposed ordinance providing for the levy of taxes sufficient to pay principal of and interest on an issuance of \$114,500,000.00 General Obligation School Assistance Bonds Series B (1984) of the Chicago School Finance Authority.

Alderman Orr moved to suspend the rules temporarily for the immediate consideration of and action upon the said proposed ordinance. The motion was *Lost* by yeas and nays as follows:
