Rules Suspended -- AMENDMENT OF TITLE 2 OF MUNICIPAL
CODE OF CHICAGO AND 1995 ANNUAL
APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO
FIX COMPENSATION FOR
ELECTED CITY
OFFICIALS.

Alderman Mazola presented a proposed ordinance to amend Title 2 of the Municipal Code of Chicago and the 1995 Annual Appropriation Ordinance to fix the compensation for elected city officials.

Alderman Burke moved to *Suspend the Rules Temporarily* to permit immediate consideration of and action upon the said proposed ordinance. The motion *Prevailed* by yeas and nays as follows:

Thereupon, on motion of Alderman Burke, the said proposed ordinance was *Passed* by yeas and nays as follows:

Alderman Natarus moved to reconsider the foregoing vote. The motion was lost.

The following is said ordinance as passed:

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Section 2-8-040 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by deleting the language bracketed and inserting the language in italics, as follows:

2-8-040 Compensation For Aldermen.

The salary of aldermen elected in [1991] 1995 and during any other term thereafter [, unless otherwise provided by law] shall be at a rate of [\$55,000.00] \$75,000.00 per annum.

No other City of Chicago salary shall be allowed any alderman except as herein provided.

SECTION 2. Section 2-152-050 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by deleting the language bracketed and inserting the language in italics, as follows:

2-152-050 Salaries -- Annual Appropriation -- Clerk, Treasurer And Mayor.

The salaries of all officers and employees of the City, not otherwise fixed, shall be determined and fixed by the City Council in the annual appropriation ordinance.

The annual salaries of the *following* officers [hereinafter mentioned] *elected in 1995 and during any term thereafter* are hereby fixed as follows:

City Clerk	[\$85,000.00]	\$105,000.00
City Treasurer	[85,000.00]	105,000.00
Mayor	[115,000.00]	170,000.00

The salaries of all officers and employees shall be as herein provided regardless of any prior inconsistent statute or ordinance.

SECTION 3. The Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the year 1995 as previously amended is hereby further amended by striking certain language and figures and inserting certain language and figures as indicated in the attached Exhibit A.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
