No quorum present.

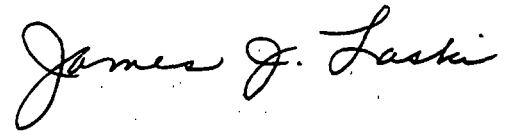
