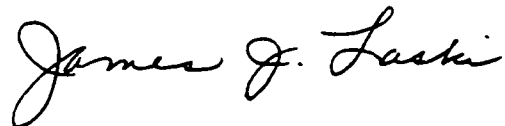
Session Resumed After Recess.
